

## **Bomb that was dropped on Rodger Street, Cellardyke, on 25<sup>th</sup> October 1940**

Several bombs were dropped in a raid by a Heinkel 111 – a German Luftwaffe bomber.

One bomb caused severe damage to house No. 6 and fishermen's lofts were demolished. Most of the houses in the street and nearby were also damaged. However, no serious injuries were recorded.

Other bombs fell in the district during the raid and two people were killed at Backfields, Cornceres.

The bomb weighed 250 Kg (550 lbs).
