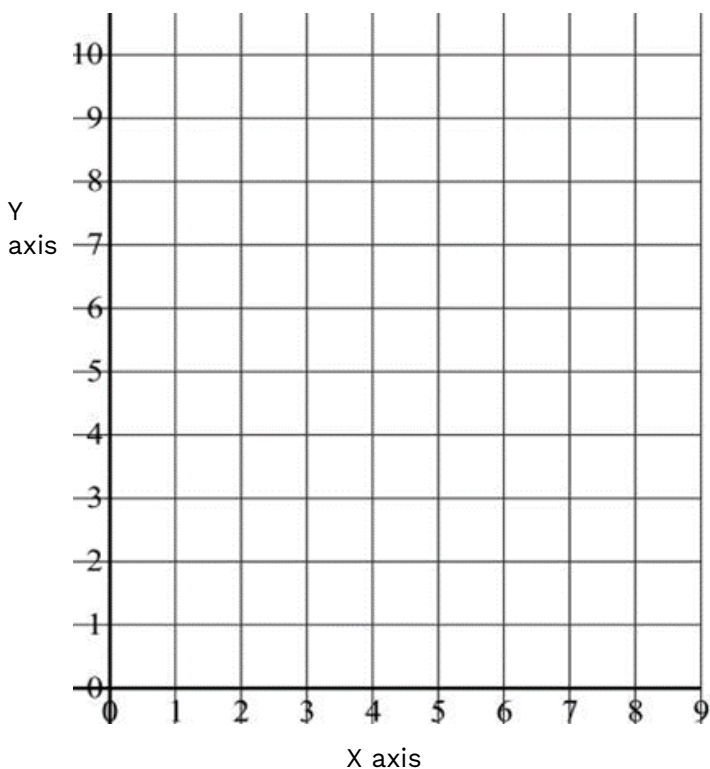
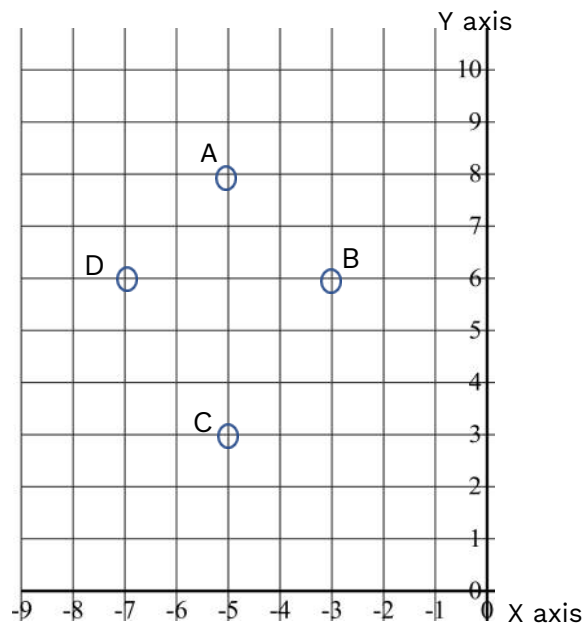


Fishermen used to wear jumpers called ganseys. Ganseys are knitted with different repeating patterns. Some patterns are connected to the coastal town they were knitted in.

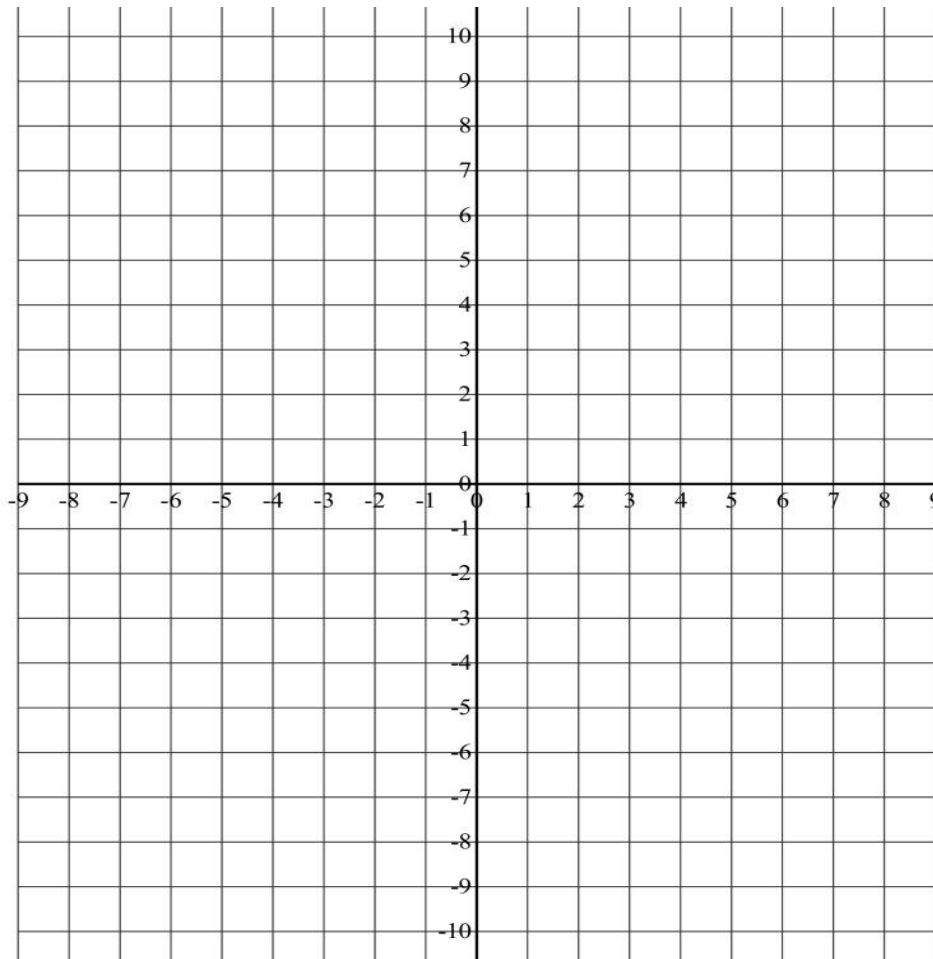
2) Can you create an anchor pattern using the following coordinates?

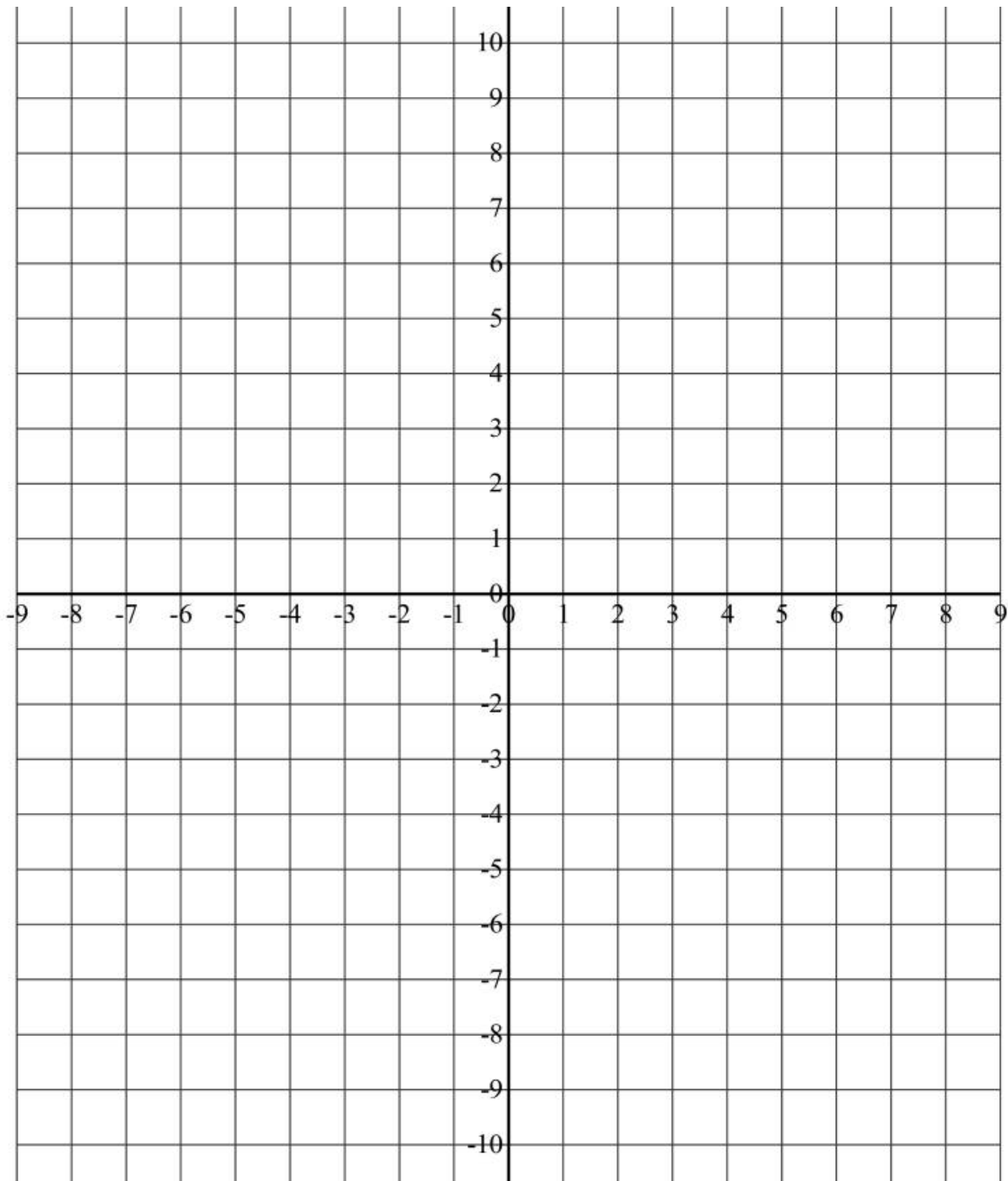
3) Can you write coordinates to make a pattern for your own gansey?
